Adobe Spark Video - basic instructions

☐ Create a project folder called "Video Narrative"
☐ Add the original video clips you have shot
Download media and add it to the folder
☐ Music - a soundtrack from youtube.com/audiolibrary
☐ Optional - images (<u>pexels.com</u>) or video clips (<u>videos.pexels.com</u>)
☐ Log in at spark.adobe.com - use a Google login with ND netid@nd.edu
☐ New Project - click the large plus sign, choose "Video" (way at the bottom)
☐ Title - "Video Narrative"
☐ Template - start from scratch
☐ Theme - choose one that appeals to you and you can change later
☐ Music - upload your soundtrack
☐ Add Text "slides" - opening title and closing credits
☐ Add Video "slides" for your clips - trim extra footage at beginnings and ends
☐ Layouts - use "Fullscreen" for everything or try different ones
Optional - add Photos or Icons
Optional - add a voice recording to one or more slides
☐ Edit - rearrange the order of the slides, adjust volume, etc.
